I think there is a substantial likelihood that this is the same man as <u>Aaron McWhorter S4596</u> who says he served under Hampton in NC and SC while living in Mecklenburg County NC. His statements as to his service and timing thereof in his application is not consistent with his listing as a member of this company but he would not be the first old veteran whose statements as to time and place of service were 'confused.'
