MUSTER AND PAY ROLLS OF CAPT. ABEL WESTFALL'S COMPANY OF THE 8TH VIRGINIA CONTINENTAL REGIMENT OF FOOT, MAY 1776 - MARCH 1778 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris.

[The Eighth Virginia Infantry Regiment was authorized by Virginia on 1 Dec 1775 and first commanded by Col. Peter Muhlenberg. Its troops were mainly from northwestern Virginia and the southwestern part of Pennsylvania then claimed by Virginia. Because so many from the area spoke German, the regiment was sometimes called the German Regiment. It comprised ten companies, number Six of which was commanded by Capt. Abel Westfall (pension application VAS612). This company was recruited from Hampshire County – since divided into Hampshire, Hardy, Mineral, and part of Morgan counties in West Virginia.

Most of the troops in the 8th Regiment, including Westfall's company, saw their first action in June 1776 during the combined British naval and land attack on Fort Moultrie on Sullivans Island at the mouth of Charleston Harbor in South Carolina. Col. Muhlenberg's Regiment arrived on the 18th. At the height of the Battle of Sullivans Island on June 28, the regiment was at Breach Inlet at the northern end of Sullivans Island, where it helped protect Fort Moultrie from assault by land during the naval bombardment.

The regiment then had an estimated strength of 500 men (not counting about 40 who deserted on the march from Virginia). Because this number was short by about 140, Congress was reluctant to take the 8th Regiment into the Continental Line. On August 13, however, Congress relented and took the regiment under Continental Establishment retroactively to May 27 to legitimize its having served outside Virginia.

On 21 Feb 1777 Muhlenberg was promoted to Brigadier General, and Col. Abraham Bowman (W396) took command. After the Battle of Sullivans Island some of the 8th Virginia Regiment remained in the South (referred to as being in the "South Service" in the following rolls). The remainder returned to Virginia, mustered at Fredericksburg, and marched to Pennsylvania to join the main army under Washington. The regiment participated in the battles of Brandywine on 11 Sep 1777 and Germantown on 4 Oct 1777. Capt. Westfall resigned on the 22nd or 23rd of November 1777. Col. Bowman resigned in December 1777 and was replaced by Col. John Nevill. After wintering at Valley Forge, the remnants of the regiment participated in the Battle of Monmouth on 28 June 1778.

Mainly because of sickness and desertions, the company never had its full complement of 64 Privates. On 10 April 1778 the terms of enlistment for many in the company expired, and at the muster eight days later there were only nine in the company, including officers. The situation was not unique to the company Westfall had commanded or to the 8th Regiment. On 14 Sep 1778 at White Plains NY the depleted Virginia Continental regiments were consolidated. (See http://revwarapps.org/b138.pdf.) What remained of the 8th Virginia Regiment was absorbed into the 3rd Virginia Regiment, and the 12th Virginia Continental Regiment became the new 8th Virginia Continental Regiment with different personnel.

In the following transcriptions full names, alternative spellings, and the numbers of pension or bounty-land applications are added in brackets where the name first occurs. [?] indicates an undeciphered or uncertain word. The same names appear on multiple rolls, often with different spellings.

The pay received can be calculated from the duration of service given in the payroll and the following rates of pay: Capt. Westfall was paid first at the rate of 26²/₃ dollars (equal to £8) per month until 7 Oct 1776, then at the rate of 40 dollars (£12) per month; Second Lt. Berwick received £8 per month; Ensigns Pritchard and Greenholm received £4 and £4.14.0 per month for their respective services; the five Sergeants were each paid £2.12.0 per month; the three Corporals, the Drummer, and the Fifer were each paid £2.4.0 per month; Privates received £2 per month.]
