From my long absence & the present dispersed situation of my Regiment, it is impossible for me to give an exact return but in the above the Officers stand as they rank in the line (except Capt Allan who perhaps has no rank at all in the line)

The dates of their commissions I have given so far as they fall within my knowledge. As to the non Commissioned Officers and privates, according to the best accounts I am able to get of them their numbers & situations stand as follows. To the Southard with Capt (*) twenty six for the war and between thirty & forty whose terms of inlistment are nearly expired. And in the State of Virginia about thirteen for the War with Capt Moody, one with me, one with Capt Clay, as I am informed * one with the Adjutant; besides five or six others with Capt Moody whose terms of inlistment are nearly expired.

Feb 4th 1781
