We the Subscribers do hereby Acknowledge ourselves fairly Inlisted as Continental Soldiers for the Term of three Years or during the War, and do each of us Oblige ourselves to conform to & Strictly Observe the Rules and Regulations as pointed out by the Continental Congress in their Articles of War & we each of us do further Bind & Oblige ourselves to Obey punctually all the Lawful Commands of the Officers placed over us & and in all cases to Demean ourselves as Good & Faithful Soldiers, Witness our hands at Camp near Halifax the 2nd day of September 1778
