NOTES

The first column headed "No." is generally blank except for check marks and dashes not transcribed, and the X in the third row. In some cases the first name begins in this column

In the column headed "Pay per Day" the unit of currency was pounds of tobacco. On the second page in different handwriting someone has entered the equivalent in pounds, shillings, and pence.

James L. Lynch has found that "Lee Royupsha" was Leroy Upshaw, and "John Henryplod" was John Henry Plod.

"Lan¹. Carter" appears to be Landon Carter, who signed a legislative petition appealing the sentence to eight months service. "Pleasant Dawson" may be Pleasant Davison, as appears on the legislative petition. The following signed the legislative petition but are missing from the payroll: Joseph Pender, William Bowman.

"Battle of Cambdon" refers to the Battle of Camden SC on 16 Aug 1780.

"hilsborough" refers to Hillsborough NC, the place of rendezvous before and after the Battle of Camden.

[*] indicates that part of the page is missing.

Pension applications were filed for the following soldiers on the list: James Alexander W8322, William Bowman S16328, James Hopkins W3553, Gideon Martin S31232, Henry McLain S7196. In addition, Absolem Pollard W8527 may be the same soldier listed on the payroll, but he applied under pension laws covering Continental service only and did not mention militia service.

ADDITIONAL ANNOTATIONS TO THE PAYROLL OF CAPT. AZARIAH MARTIN'S COMPANY OF MILITIA FROM AMHERST COUNTY VA

At the Battle of Camden SC on 16 Aug 1780 the militiamen of Virginia scattered. Capt. Azariah Martin's company was singled out for court martial, and many of hi company were sentenced to serve eight months in the regular (Continental) service.
