[Note: This is a partial list of the veterans and widows of deceased veterans wounded or killed in the Revolutionary War. The South Carolina Legislature awarded pensions to veterans who were wounded while serving in the South Carolina Continental Line, State Troops or Militia during the Revolutionary War as well as to widows whose husbands were killed in action during the Revolutionary War. This list appears to be of pensioners paid by the Columbia branch of the State Treasury with there being another list paid by the Charleston branch of the State Treasury. To date, I've not found the Charleston list, if one exists.]

- 4. Is a Schedule of Arrears due the Treasury from Sundry Tax Collectors and Sheriffs [not transcribed
- 5. Contains a List of Pensioners payable at said Office
- 6. Is in Account Current between the Treasury Office in Charleston and the Treasury at Columbia [not transcribed]
