This man says he was at Kings Mountain under Capt. James Tigert [a/k/a James Ligert James Taggert, James Tygert] and Col. John Hampton of the NC Militia. Evidence that such a unit was under the command of Col. James Williams of SC is given in the SC Indent records in an indent given to Gabriel Anderson SC180 who received an indent from Major John Hampton for goods taken on October 7, 1780 pursuant to the orders of Col. Williams.

This man is unlikely to have been at KM. His application has conflicting statements in that he says he was wounded at Gates Defeat and stayed in the hospital some time recovering. The next battle he lists after making this statement is the battle of Cowan's ford. He lists KM among the battles he participated in without giving any specifics or stating under whom he served.
