[Note: The file only contains the standard response letter indicating that the records of the war Department were destroyed in the fire of 1800 and consequently there is no information regarding this veteran other than the issuance of Warrant No. 1850 4 400 acres of bounty land issued February 16, 1798 to John Richards, Virginia, Assignee based on the services of Major Thomas Ridley of the Virginia line during the war of the revolution.]

The <u>Library of Virginia</u> online digital collection relating to bounty land claims honored by that state contains the following documents relating to this veteran:

I do certify that Thomas Ridley was in the Service of the United States in the 4th Virginia Regiment on Continental Establishment in March 1776 and was afterwards promoted to the Rate of Major, and as such continued to the end of the late War with Great Britain. Given under my hand this 30th day of July 1807 –

Jno Stith late Captain [John Stith] 4th Virginia Regiment

[the attestation beneath the above certificate more clearly indicates that it was signed by John Stith.]

I do certify that by an arrangement of the Virginia Line made at Chesterfield Court House February 1781, it appears that Major Thomas Ridley became a Supernumerary Officer and further that I issued the Commutations due to a Major of Infantry in his favor.
