[There are no service records or declarations in this file, same having been destroyed in the fire that destroyed the War Department's records in 1800. There is a typed letter dated May 8, 1934, indicating that a John Vance was issued Warrant No. 2272 on November 22, 1791, for services rendered as a Lieutenant in the Revolutionary War in the NC Continental line. The warrant was issued to Robert Furgerson, administrator. The letter goes on to read in part:

"This office has no records of the statements made in the application for bounty land, because of the destruction of papers in such early applications when the War Office was burned in 1800, therefore, no further data relative to the soldier, and none whatever to his family."]
