Winchester Barracks Dec'r 28th 1781

I do hereby Certify that James Wood Esq'r was appointed Colonel to the 12th Virg'a. Reg't. on the 12th of Nov'r 1776 and is now in actual service.

I do hereby Certify upon Honor that my Commission of Colonel of Infantry in the Continental Army Bears Date the 12th day of November 1776, that I was arranged to Command the 1st Virginia Regiment in January 1783, and that I Continued in Service till the final Discharge of the Army on the Conclusion of the War.
