Pension Application of Peter Field Archer BLWt300-200 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

KNOW All Men by these Presents, that I Peterfield Archer late a Lieut. in Continental Line in State of Virg'a of the County of Powhatan and State of Virginia have this day bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and assign over to Albin Gordon of the county of Amherst and State of Virg'a all my right, title, and interest n and to Two hundred acres of Land, due me in consideration of my services in the army of the United States, to the end of the late war with Great-Britain, under the command of Gen'l Green [sic: Nathanael Greene] South Carolina agreeable to an act of Congress, and I do moreover request, order and direct Henry Knox, Esquire, Secretary at War for the time being, or his successors, to issue to said Albin Gordon his heirs and assigns, in his or their own name as assignee of me, the said Peterfield Archer a warrant for the land aforesaid, and on receipt of the same, I do hereby ratify and confirm any receipt or other instrument in writing, that he the said Albin Gordon may necessarily sign, or procure to be signed, in touching the premises aforesaid, as fully as I could do, if I was personally present.
