I do hereby Certify that Levi Tucker had no own Brother but Zadoc Tucker that he was killed in the War between the United States of America & Great Britain, & further that the s'd Levi Tucker administer'd upon his (the said Zadoc Tuckers) property & did draw a Certificate from the Delaware State for his pay Sworn to and subscribe to this 20 day of July 1809 Ephraim Burron Esq George hisXmark hutton
