This is to Certify that Daniel De Benneville appears on the Musters of the Virginia Line as a Surgeon of the 13th Virginia Regiment and has been settled with by the United States for his pay and commutation as such, and has also received his Bounty Land [400 acres] as allowed by Congress to a Surgeon.
