Warrant application of John Armstrong BLWt60-450
Transcribed by Will Graves

[Letter from the War Department dated August 21, 1937 reads as follows:

“The Records of this office show that Warrant #60, was issued September 12, 1789 for four hundred fifty acres of bounty land, on account of the service of John Armstrong, Lieutenant Colonel of the North Carolina, War of the Revolution.

“There are no further data on file as to the service of this John Armstrong, and no data as to his family, due to the destruction of the papers in such early bounty land claims, when the War Office was burned.”]
