Reference is made your request for information in regard to John Seva, a soldier of the Revolutionary War.

On a list of invalid pensioner's who have been in receipt of pensions under the Act of September 29, 1789, at the Savannah agency in Georgia the name of John Seva appears. He served in the Revolution as a private and was pensioned at the rate of \$60 per annum.

There are no papers on file relative to this soldier and no further data the calls of the destruction of papers in such claims when the War Office was burned in 1800.
