Pension Application of Edward Hall R20511 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

I Edward Hall of the County of Buckingham in the State of Virginia do hereby declare, that I enlisted in the Continental line of the army of the revolution for and during the war, and continued in its service untill its termination, at which period I was a Seargeant in Captain Fitzgeralds Company in the Second Virginia Regiment on Continental line, and also declare that I never received a Certificate for the reward of \$80 to which I was entitled under the resolve of Congress, passed the 15<sup>th</sup> May 1778 and I further declare, that I was not on the 15<sup>th</sup> March 1827 on the pension list of the United States

[signed] Edward Hall Sept. 9<sup>th</sup> 1828

NOTE: Hall's claim was rejected apparently because his name could not be found on muster or pay rolls.
