



Carroll one of the Justices of the peace in and for said County and after first being Qualified according to law deposeth and saith that he was personally acquainted with John Endsley in the days of the Revolution whose widow Deborah Endsley now lives in the State of Tennessee in Blount County, and has made application for a pension which is due her upon the account of the services that the said John Endsley Rendered in said war. This deponent further saith that he well recollects that the said John Endsley and himself served in the same company upwards of six months under Captain Isaac White who was a Captain of horse infantry or Cavalry. This deponent saith that he believes that the name of the Colonel of the horse man was by the name of Smith and under General Rutherford and that this term of service was done in the year 1781 Sworn to and subscribed before me this day and date first above written.
