Pension Application of Philip Buzan S30304 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[13 May 1851] Know all men by these Presents, That I Jesse Buzan only surviving Child and heir at law of Phillip Buzan dec'd late of Daviess County Indiana and who was a soldier in the Virginia line in the Army of the Revolution, do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Geo H. Monsaratt & Stephen F. J. Trabue my true and lawful attornies for me and in my name to prosecute against the Government of the United States the claim I have for consideration of the services of the said Phillip Buzan dec'd... [the rest not transcribed].

NOTE: A document in the file dated 15 Aug 1851 certified that Philip Buzan died on 18 Nov 1844 leaving four children – James Buzan, Elgin Buzan, Jesse Buzan, and Allen Buzan – the first two having since died unmarried, leaving no widow or child. On 12 Sep 1851 Andrew J. Buzan was named administrator of the estate of Philip Buzan. A document dated 24 Oct 1851 states that Jesse Buzan, James Buzan, and Eliza Buzan were the surviving children and heirs of Philip Buzan.
