I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]

To the Honorable the President, and other members of the Senate and To the Honorable Speaker of the House of Representatives of South Carolina –

Your Petitioners Humbly Sheweth – that Morris Calliham [sic] a Citizen of Eighty-five years of Age, is an Object we Conceive, Justly Intitled to the Gratitude of this State, for his past Services & Sufferings, he has been a Citizen of This State for upwards of Sixty Years, was a pilate [pilot] to General Grant's [British General James Grant's] Army in the Year 1759 [in a Campaign against the Cherokee Indians in the Western Part of South Carolina] Against the Cherokees & discharged the Trust with Great fedelety [fidelity] – In the Revolution he was wormly [warmly] Attached to This Country, and Acted the part of a Soldier and Citizen which is well known by many - In the Year 1779 whilst himself & son were out on Actual Service on an Expedition Against the Enemy – a partie [party] of Indians Attacked and burnt his house – murdered his wife and Seven Children & Seven negroes, & Burnt all he possessed – he has since got a famely [family] a wife and four small Children, now living with him, but from his advanced Age, is no longer able to Support neither himself nor them, with the Common necessities of life, has never till now made Application nor received any public relieve, or Any Compensation from his Country, has ever supported the Character of an Honest good man, and his distressed Family, that we take the Liberty to State the foregoing facts (as we justly believe) to the Legislator [sic, Legislature] – and hope they will Grant such relief, as they in their wisdom and goodness, may think meat [sic] for which your petitioners will pray
