I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]

The Gentlemen Commissioners appointed to Settle with and pay off the late State Brigade Commanded by General Sumter [Thomas Sumter], will please deliver to the said General Sumter Such Indent or Indents as appear due to & provided for William Lyons late a Soldier in Colonel Wade Hampton's Regiment, agreeable to the Assignment of his Conveyance to Richard Simmons, having Received from the said General Sumter full & ample Satisfaction therefore. Given under my hand this 11th August 1786
