Unfortunately, the file does not contain the petition by Mansfield or any other documents indicating the nature of the services rendered by Thomas E Kelly. The only date I could find in the documents was December 10, 1852 being the date of a resolve by the Senate concurring in the report of the committee on pensions recommending the payment of the arrears.
