

Carolina Continental Regiment this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Five Hundred & Twenty four pounds nineteen Shillings & nine pence half penny Sterling for his pay and Subsistence to the 1st January 1782 and for his Additional State pay to the 1st day of May 1783 as per Certificate from the Auditor General."]
