[Methodology: Spelling, punctuation and/or grammar have been corrected in some instances for ease of reading and to facilitate searches of the database. Where the meaning is not compromised by adhering to the spelling, punctuation or grammar, no change has been made. Corrections or additional notes have been inserted within brackets and footnotes. Blanks appearing in the transcripts reflect blanks in the original. A bracketed question mark indicates that the word or words preceding it represent(s) a guess by me. The word 'illegible' or 'indecipherable' appearing in brackets indicates that at the time I made the transcription, I was unable to decipher the word or phrase in question. Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]

[p 2: As evidenced by the Indent posted below, a veteran by the name of Archibald McDonnell was granted an indent in the amount of 68 Pounds 8 Shillings and 10 Pence Sterling for service as a private in the South Carolina Continental line from 1779 to 1783.]

SOUTH-CAROLINA.

PURSUANT to an ACT of the GENERAL ASSEMBLY passed the 16th of March, 1790, &c. the COMMISSIONERS of the TREASURY, have this day delivered to

this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of *Eighty eight pounds eight shillings and ten pence* Sterling for service as a private in the South Carolina Continental line from 1779 to 1783 inclusive of Principal and Interest.

the said *Archibald McDonald* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns will be entitled to receive from this Office the Sum of *sixty eight pounds eight shillings and ten pence* Sterling on the demand

one Year's Interest on the Principal Sum of *sixty eight pounds eight shillings and ten pence* Sterling and the like Interest Annually *from the 1st of January 1783*

The said *Archibald McDonald* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *sixty eight pounds eight shillings and ten pence* Sterling on the 1st of the said *Month of January* 1783, and the said *Archibald McDonald* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes,) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner abovementioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforesaid ACT.

GIVEN under our Hands at the TREASURY-OFFICE, in CHARLESTON, the *fourth* Day of *April* one thousand seven hundred and eighty *seven*.
