Dollars 32,580 Camp at Augusta August 14th 1780 I hereby Certify that the State of South Carolina is Indebted to Mr. Edmund Bugg in the sum of Thirty-Two Thousand five Hundred and Eighty Dollars being for 3238 bushels Corn at Ten Dollars per bushel and a Stack [of] fodder at Two Hundred Dollars – for the use of the Troops under the Command of Brigadier General Andrew Williamson – for which he is to receive an Interest of 10 per cts [10%] per annum until paid as per Resolution of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina
