Pension Application of Thomas Smith W6128

State of Virginia }

Hanover County } To wit — On this 6<sup>th</sup> day of Feby 1837 personally came before the subscriber a justice of the peace in and for the said County in the state aforesaid, Susan Smith, a resident of said County & State, aged 86 years in November next, who being first duly sworn according to Law, doth, on her oath, make the following Declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provission made by the Act of Congress, passed July 4<sup>th</sup> 1836: That she is the widow of Thomas Smith late of said county who was a soldier from Virginia in the War of the Revolution and from the said County of Hanover. That he returned home some time after the Seige of York [28 Sep - 19 Oct 1781]. As to the circumstances of his service — what part of the Army he belonged to — the Officers names, her mind and memory will not enable her to make a statement. She further declares that she was married to the said Thomas Smith in said County, several years before the said war commenced, and had four children before that time. That she was married by one Parson Barrett, after being duly asked in Church three times according to the custom of that day. That her husband, the aforesaid Thomas Smith died on the 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> of April 10 years ago. And that she has remained a widow ever since that period, as will more fully appear by reference to the proof hereto annexed —

## NOTE:

The file includes a deposition dated 6 Feb 1837 that reads in part as follows: "Elizabeth Smith aged 40 years and Nancy Smith aged 37 years in May next... deposeth that they are grand-children of Thomas Smith late of said County, and Susan Smith his wife, now his widow; That their father Robert Smith was the second child of said Thomas and Susan as they have always understood & believe. That their said father moved to Chillicothe, and if living at this time is 60 years old."

A Treasury-Department document states that the Administrator of Susan Smith received the final pension payment up to 8 Jan 1840, the date of her death.
