Pension Application of Charles L. A. Smith X728 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[The pension file is designated simply "R," indicating a rejected application. The file number X728 is by HeritageQuest.]

Know all men by these presents that I Jacob Smith of Fauqr [Fauquier] County & state of Virginia do hereby constitute & appoint Rev W Payne of said County & State my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name and stead to prosecute recover & receive whatever claim or pension I may be entitled to receive from the Gen Govmt because of the services of my father Charles L A Smith deceased for the supposed term of five years as private in the War of the Revolution. Witness my hand & seal this 6th June 1855 [signed] Jacob Smith

NOTE: A letter in the file states that Charles Smith served from Fairfax County VA and died there about 1796, leaving a widow after about 20 years of marriage, who died in 1814.
