State Pension Application of Thomas Owen VAS100 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[From pension records in the Library of Virginia:]

I DO with the advice of the Council hereby certify, that Ann Owen widow of Thomas Owen who was a private in the first Regiment of Artillery and died in the service of The United States is entitled to the sum of Twelve Pounds yearly; which allowance is to commence from the first day of January 1786

GIVEN under my hand as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, at Richmond, (the Governor being absent) this $15^{\rm th}$ day of June 1787
