These may Certify that Daniel Donnakin enlisted on the seventh day of December one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven to serve as Soldier in the fifth Virginia Regiment on Continental establishment for and during the term of three years which term he has fulfilled with fidelity, and is thereby entitled to a full discharge from the Service and also to the bounty of one hundred acres of land allowed by act of Assembly of the State of Virginia [illegible word] bounties in land for Military services and to all other benefits and advantages that may arise in consequence of his said Services
