
[Methodology: Spelling, punctuation and/or grammar have been corrected in some instances for ease of reading and to facilitate searches of the database. Where the meaning is not compromised by adhering to the spelling, punctuation or grammar, no change has been made. Corrections or additional notes have been inserted within brackets or footnotes. Blanks appearing in the transcripts reflect blanks in the original. A bracketed question mark indicates that the word or words preceding it represent(s) a guess by me. The word 'illegible' or 'indecipherable' appearing in brackets indicates that at the time I made the transcription, I was unable to decipher the word or phrase in question. Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]

I Benjamin Marnix of Gloucester County being now seventy-one years of age doth testify that I knew Thomas James of this County he enlisted in the Virginia Continental line in the revolutionary war he marched away from this County after which time I never saw him again and I cannot say how long he was in service. I was in the militia service myself. – Witness my hand and seal this the second day of May in the year 1833

I Certify that I was well acquainted with Thomas James he enlisted in the Virginia Continental line at an early Period of the Revolutionary war and he served to the end of the war I have seen him often times after he came home, he went from Gloucester County, where I enlisted at in the year 1778 I am now in my seventy second year of age I was discharged the 10th day of July 1781 I was at the battle of the Cowpens the 17th day of January in the year 1781. As witness my hand and seal this the 18th day of May in the year 1833.
