Virginia Pension Claim of James Beck VAS1200

Know all men by these presents that I James Beck of the Corporation of Fredericksburg and State of Virginia have made, ordained, constituted and appointed and by these presents doth make, ordain, constitute and appoint Samuel Greenhow Esq'r. of the City of Richmond, and State aforesaid, my true and lawful attorney for me & in my name to ask, demand, and receive of the proper officer any warrant or warrants which I may be entitled to by virtue of an act, passed at the last session of the Legislature of the state aforesaid entitled "An act placing James Beck and Thomas Galford on the Pension list," and which said act grants to me one Hundred dollars pr annum payable on or after 10th day of Jan'y in each year – In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of January 1812.
