Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]

By Virtue of the Order of the Honorable Major General Greene [Nathanael Greene] Thomas Jones the bearer hereof belonging to the [paper damaged and word illegible] Troop 1st Regiment Light Dragoons commanded by Colonel George Baylor has leave to be absent from his said Regiment until called for, then to Rendezvous at such place as shall be appointed in the State of Virginia under pain of being considered and treated as a Deserter the said Summons being published in the Virginia newspapers 3 weeks successively to be considered as sufficient notice. Given at Nelsons ferry this 12 of June 1783
