Febuary 23rd 1809

I Certify that Joel Fostor was a Soldier in the Continental Army for three years and seved under me for apart of the time then detacht to the Southward under Colo Buford and was wounded in the action call'd. Bufords Defeat [defeat of Abraham Buford at the Battle of Waxhaws SC, 29 May 1780] and never joind

me again Hezekiah Morton

formerly Capt. in the continental line

I Certify that Joel Foster was Wounded in Bufords defeat

NOTES:

Hezekiah Morton (BLWt69-300) was a Captain in the 8th Virginia Continental Regiment. John L. Crute (S24980) was an Ensign at the Battle of Waxhaws.

The bounty-warrant file includes a typed transcription of the federal pension application of a different Joel Foster (W11008) inscribed, "Presented by Dr. L. S. Foster of Williamsburg, 4/16/23."
