Spotsylvania March Court 1830

Ordered that the Estate of Moses Green deceased be committed to the [illegible word] of John McCoule[?] Sheriff of this County for administration, he having been dead more than three months, and no person having applied for administration on his estate. And it appears to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Moses Green died on the 27th day of May 1829.
