The word 'illegible' or 'indecipherable' appearing in brackets indicates that at the time I made the transcription, I was unable to decipher the word or phrase in question. Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]

To the honorable the Speaker & House of Delegates The Petition of John Kerby humbly Sheweth.

That your Petitioner acted as Commissary and Quarter-Master for the Troops stationed at the half way House in the County of York from the 30th day of October 1780 to the 23rd day of December following, and also from the 21st of January 1781 to the 25th of March following, for which Services he has not received any compensation whatsoever.

Your Petitioner therefore prays the House to make him such allowance for his said Services, and to be paid in the same manner, as hath be [been] granted to other Quarter Master's in the Like case.

Kirby's Petition November 2nd, 1793 To Claims Rejected

Mr. Kirby,

Sir If you still continued to act as Quarter Master at the half way House, it is necessary that you immediately provide everything sufficiently that belong to your Department as a large number of my men will March from this to the halfway House tomorrow Mor'g [morning]. You are to observe that it is a part of your Duty to provide Houses for Barracks for the man, which I expect you will immediately do, at & near Mr. Wild's
