I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

This is to Certify that Jno. Pinn¹ Inlisted with me the 8th day of February 1777 to serve the Term of 3 years as mariner in the Navy which Time he Serv'd True and Faithfully and the Time being Expired he is hereby Discharged. Given under my hand this 8th day of February 1780
