Virginia documents pertaining to David McDorment VAS2204 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris.

[The following are from bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia:]

Know all men By these presents that I David McDorment late a soldier in the Army under the Command of Col Posey [Thomas Posey BLWt1733-450] in the united States of America in the [illegible word] war, [undeciphered word] & in Consideration to the Sum of Five Pounds current money of Virginia to me in hand paid & Before the [two undeciphered words] of these presents By Wm. White have sold transferd & assign'd unto the said william White his heirs & assigns forever all the Right title Interest & Claim of the land I am Intitled to from the Congress of the United States of America for my services as a Soldier in during the late War & I the said David McDorment do hereby Appoint the said wm White my true & Lawful attorney agreeable to [undeciphered word] and solicit & obtain in my Name or otherwise [several undeciphered words] use & Behoof of the said wm White his heirs & assigns for [several undeciphered words] from the Congress of the united States of America a grant or grants [several undeciphered words] the land aforesaid hereby Ratifying all & whatsoever my said attorney may Do Respecting the same & the said David McDorment for myself & my heirs Executors & admis's do Covenant promise & grant & will not Revoke the power of attorney herein contained or Do anything which shall Impede the said wm, white in [undeciphered word] or obtaining a grant or grants to a patent or patents for the land aforesaid in witnes whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this 6th Day of July one thousand seven hundred & Ninety one

I certify that David McDorment served as a soldier in my Detachment to the southward
