State of Kentucky Woodford County to wit.

Appeared before me one of the Justices of the peace in & for[?] s'd county John Allen [pension application S30808] and made Oath that he was a Soldier in Capt Wm. Henderson's [William Henderson] Company belonging to Col Daniel Morgan's Rifle Regiment, & knew [undeciphered word] David Allen. That said David [several undeciphered words] to serve in Capt [several undeciphered words] Henry's Regiment [several undeciphered words] said David enlisted to [several undeciphered words] Company in Colo. John Green's [BLWt866-500] Regim't in the Virg'a Continental line, [several undeciphered words] always understood, honorably served out the said time. Given under my Hand this 24th day of October 1821. Rich'd Fox

Claim of David Allen

The affidavit of a respectable witness (at least so says a magistrate) states that D. Allen enlisted to serve 3 yrs in Va. Cont. Line & did serve it out honorably. T. Green
