Peter Ammond private in the first Virginia Reg't once of the 8<sup>th</sup> reg't having served the United States from the [undeciphered] March 76 to this date and being enlisted for the War is hereby discharged the American Army. [one or two undeciphered words] the fifteenth Septem'r 1783

pass'd[?] [undeciphered word] Jones [undeciphered word] [signed] Wm Johnston [William Johnston] Cap 22<sup>d</sup> Decm'r 1832/ a Copy Jno [undeciphered]/ Au Dunscomb

The Register [of the Land Office] will please to deliver whatever may be found due me on the within to Colo [Oliver] Towles 1st Dec'r 1784 Peter Amond
Test/ [undeciphered] Walker a Coppy [undeciphered] White

The within Peter Ammond was enlisted for the war and served the time mentioned in his discharge. [signed] James Wood late BG [Brigadier General]
