


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Virginia documents pertaining to William Anderson VAS2243

[The following are from [bounty-land records in the Library of Virginia](#):]

I do certify that William Anderson was enlisted for & faithfully served as a soldier three years in the 14th Virginia regiment which regiment I commanded. The discharge which Anderson had, is lodged with the vouchers for his arrears of pay & depreciation; and at his request, to enable him to obtain his proportion of land, I certify the above from my own personal knowledge, Anderson being the driver of my own baggage waggon a considerable part of the time. Blandford Feb. 17 1795
