I Sygnal Moore of the County of Chesterfield and State of Virginia do hereby certify that Robert Andrews of the aforesaid State & County did enlist as a Soldier in in the Service of the United States about the begining of the American Revolution he served the term for which he enlisted and obtained a discharge. he then returned to the town of Chesterfield which was in the years 1779 or 1780 he remained at home a few months and again enlisted as I believe for the continuance of the war. Given under my hand and seal this fourth day of Nov 1839
