

Certify that [illegible] Bagnall Inlisted the [one or two illegible words] 1776 in the Cont. line for the terme of three years, that he reinlisted the 2^d[?] Dec. 1778 for the war & was made prisoner at Charlestown [Charleston SC] the 12th [May] 1780 Given under my hand this 16th day of March 1789
