Bounty Land Warrant information relating to Calwell P. PoolVAS234 Transcribed by Will Graves

Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

I do Certify that Philip Snead a Sergeant, Joseph Bohannon, Drummer, Elisha Winn Corporal, James Winn Corporal did in the month of February in the year 1776 enlisted [sic] in my Company in the regular Service in the 6th Virginia Regiment and did perform duty, Two years. Given under my hand this 27th of October 1809

I do hereby Certify that Colwell P. Pool a Soldier did enlist in my Company between the month of January in the month of March in the year 1777 in the Regular Service in the 6th Virginia Regiment. Given under my hand this 27th of October 1809

This day came Colonel Edward P Bacon before me a Justice of the Peace for the County aforesaid & made oath that he has either lost or mislaid a Certificate granted Calwell Pettipool for land in the State of Ohio as a private in the Continental Service in the late war for three years & which said Certificate was lately [indecipherable word] to him by William Mason Esquire Given under my hand this first January 1810
