Charles Harrison Having Served the Time for which he was Ingaged, is heareby Discharged the Servis, of the United Stats; His Good Behaviour as a Soldier intitles him to the Esteem of all his Cuntreymen. Given under my hand at the Park of Artillery Neare Morris Town [Morristown NJ] the 6th Day of Feb'y 1780.
