This is to certify that Edward Randell enlisted into the continental Virginia line in the service of the United States of America on the 1st day of Nov'r 1776 to serve as a Soldier for three years. And served untill the 1st of February 1778 at which time he hired James Bayley to serve the remainder of his time, which he did and was dischargd Novem'r 1st 1779 Given under my hand this October 25th 1784.
