I Thos Bonney [Thomas Bonney S6688] hereby certify that Nathan Douge enlisted in Capt Mathews company and served three years and was regularly discharged. Given under my hand in Princess Ann [sic: Princess Anne County] this 9<sup>th</sup> of July 1832

I Malichi Carrol [sic: Malachi Carroll S8180] aged 78 years certify that I knew Nathan Douge that he enlisted in the revolutionary war and served a considerable time but cannot say how long. I certify that I was with him in Portsmouth about six months before I went to the South. Given under my hand this 10<sup>th</sup> July 1832

I William Douge aged upwards of seventy years certify that I knew Nathan Douge a soldier of the revolutionary war that he enlisted in Capt. Mathews [Thomas Mathews W17076 and R16019] company and I believe he served three years Given under my hand this 10<sup>th</sup> July 1832
