I certify that Hillary Mears [S18508] a Revolutionary pensioner & man of truth & veracity came before me & made oath that he was well acquainted with William Belote of this County & that said William Belote enlisted for the term of during the war in the 9th Va Regt in Capt Sneads [Thomas Snead] Company & was in Service until the war ended & then returned to the County. Given under my hand & seal as a Justice of the peace in & for the County of Accomack this 21<sup>st</sup> Jany 1834.

Robert Russell sen'r [W5753] a Revolutionary pensioner, & a man of truth & veracity came before me & made oath in due form of law that he served in Capt Thomas Sneads Company in the Cont'l line in the Revolutionary War & was well acquainted with William Belote and enlisted in the same Company for the term of during the War & served till the war ended. Given under my hand & seal as a Justice of the peace in & for said County this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1834.
