I do hereby Certify that Thomas Blackemore enlisted the 19 Dec'r 76 a Soldier for three years in Capt Marcus Calmes's [sic: Marquis Calmes S12674] Comp'y of the 2 Virg'a Reg;t and was killed at the Battle of German Town the 4 Day of Oct'r 1777 [Germantown 4 Oct 1777]. Given under my hand this 8th day of may 1785. Geo. Blackemore Late Lt.
