Personally appeared before me a justice of the peace for the County aforesaid, Moses Self [W19009] of the County of Westmoreland, aged seventy years and made oath, that Edward Blackmore alias Blakemore enlisted in the Continental Service & served three years & he believes afterwards reenlisted & served during the whole war. He thinks he probably enlisted under Capt Burgess Ball [Burges Ball BLWt252-500], but is not positive of that fact. Given under my hand this 7th May 1832.
