THESE are to CERTIFY that the bearer hereof James Bland private Soldier in Lt. Colo. [Henry] Lee's Legion, having fatihfully served the United States and being inlisted for the war, is hereby discharged from the American army.

Given at the war office the 21st of August 1783 By order of the Secretary at war. [Gen. Benjamin Lincoln] [signed] Jos. Carlson[?] Sec'y



Registered in the books of the regiment, [blank space] adjutant. [other side]

THE within CERTIFICATE shall not ava[il] t[he] bearer as a discharge, until the ratification of the definitive treaty of peace; previous to which time, and until proclamation thereof shall be made, he is to be considered as being on furlough.
