May 27 1784.

Then Came William Blewford before me a Justice of the peace for Northumberland County and made Oath that he Inlisted in the County Aforesaid the 2 December seventeen hundred and seventy six for the term of three years under Capt. Edwin Hull and served as a true and faithfull Soldier until the 2 December One thousand seven hundred nine [sic]. Sworn to before me Jno Rogers.

The above sworn to before me the 1st June 1784. Sam Blackwell

The above man served three years and obtained a Regular discharge from me while I commanded the 1st Virginia Brigade in December 1779.
